Beneficiaries

Middlesex-Corner Primary, formerly known as Centre School was opened in 1929. The school is situated in a small farming community in the parish of Hanover, approximately 4.5 km from Lucea the capital. Children from the districts of Mount Pleasant, Mount Carmel, Williamsfield, Kingsvale and Haughton Court are among the student body. The School's library was destroyed by fire and requires major renovations and supplies (books, chairs, shelves, tables and information technology equipment).

Lethe All Age School, is situated in south St. James near the border of Hanover and St. James. Lethe is a small rural community twelve miles from Montego Bay and most of the residents are small farmers or part time tourism workers. Hence there is minimal income and low socioeconomic status. As such the school over the years struggle to meet the needs of the students. There have been improvements in the physical appearance, technology, and academic performance of the school. Despite those gains the school is still challenged as they are not able to provide holistic development to the students. The Sports department is in need of serious improvement and is seeking assistance in this area.

Clark's Town Primary is located in Clark's Town, Trelawny. The school was established in the 1800's by the Anglican Church, but transitioned over time to become government owned. The current building dates back to 1932. The main economic activity of most parents and residents, who are of a low to middle socio-economic background, is farming; some are involved in subsistence farming, while others work in the cane farming industry. However, there is still much unemployment.
